#### ELIGIBILITY

Every High school /Junior college registered under Junior Red cross and all the colleges registered under Youth Red cross before 15-11-2024 are eligible to Participate in this contest and to win awards as follows .

The Registration fee for Junior Red cross per Institution is Rs.300/- and for Youth Red cross per Institution Rs.400/-

**YRC;**- Three Awards, First, Second and Third, for Highest Membership subscription will be given for the Institutions who have admitted Highest number of youth Red cross volunteers in their Institutions by paying Rs-6/- per volunteer before 31-12-2024.

3 Awards will be given for the Institutions in junior Red cross and another 3 Awards for the Institutions in Youth Red cross who have taken up Highest Number of plantation/ Environmental protection programs/projects before-31-12-2024

Three special awards will be given for the Principals/Nodal officer for motivating youth Red Cross volunteers in performing the above service activities.
